Lugano, a Swiss City

Lugano is a city of 65,000 people in the Sub-Alpine Lake District at the very southern tip of Switzerland; to the east, it borders the Italian province of Como. The city, situated within a natural amphitheater made up of hills and mountains overlooking the lake, is dominated by Monte Bré and Monte San Salvatore, view-points offering thrilling panoramic vistas.

Over the years, Lugano has undergone a process of constant transformation: from a mediaeval fishing village with a significant agricultural sector and rural way of life to a popular 19th-century destination for tourists; its Belle Époque heyday was followed by its present identity as a center for conference tourism.

Over the last few decades, economic development and administrative reorganization have allowed Lugano to free up the resources needed to promote new urban development projects; thanks to the establishment of Ticino University, the city now plays host to an array of specialized research institutes. It has thus been able to play a key role as a knowledge society hub. Nowadays, Lugano is an attractive city for many high added value professions typical of the new services sector.



Lugano is a modern city with a wealth of opportunities for anyone deciding to relocate there.

The city's steady growth allows newcomers to easily find accommodation, whether they prefer to live in the center or in the residential, suburban districts. Thanks to bilateral agreements, there is little paperwork for foreigners coming from the European Union.

The city offers a range of training and job-seeking opportunities. Lugano boasts schools and institutes at every level, whilst there are jobs not just in the service sector but also in industrial sectors with many companies being set up around Lugano. In this case too, there is not a lot of paperwork required to obtain a work or study permit.

In order to make Lugano even more livable, there has been a strong focus on public transport. Bus lines allow people to reach every district whilst trains and Postal Buses serve the area around Lugano
